

The 3rd NITROClubs Transnational Project Meeting event in Bucharest, Romania

On Saturday, November 5, 2022, TPM3 – Transnational Project Meeting within the NITRO Clubs EU – Network of IcT Robo Clubs project (ID 2020-1-BG01-KA202-079200), strategic partnership Erasmus+ VET initiative, took place in Bucharest, Romania, in the field of robotics, implemented by organizations from Bulgaria, Romania and Slovakia.



The event was coordinated by the Politehnica University of Bucharest. The project management meeting was attended by representatives of all organizations involved in the project consortium: Institute of Information and Communication Technologies, Bulgaria, as project leader, and "Hristo Smirnenski", Secondary School of Science and Mathematics, Bulgaria, Vocational High School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering "MV Lomonosov", Bulgaria, Professional High School of Electrical Engineering and Automation, Bulgaria, Polytechnic University of Bucharest, Romania, National Association of Public Librarians and Libraries in Romania, Romania, Technical University of Košice, Slovakia, and Industrial High School of Electrical Engineering, Košice, Slovakia, as partners.

On the occasion of this transnational project meeting, each organization reviewed the progress of the activities it was responsible for since the last meeting of the partners.

In the opening of TPM3, Monica Dragoicea, University Politehnica of Bucharest Project Coordinator, and Mihnea Alexandru Moisescu, Dean of Faculty of Automation and Computer Science, presented the main activities of UPB in the field of robotics and the intersections with the NITROClubs EU project.



Afterwards, Nayden Chivarov, NITROClubs Project Manager, and Stefan Chivarov, NITROClubs Technical Coordinator on behalf of the Institute of Information and Communication Technologies, Bulgaria, reviewed the main management activities undertaken in the period between the two intermediate project reports submitted (15.10.2021 – 30.09.2022).

Thematic presentations followed on the progress recorded in the achieving the intellectual outputs under work, namely: Progress Report & IO4 Contribution Results, intervention sustained by Monica Drăgoicea, University Politehnica Bucharest (UPB), Progress Report & IO5 Contribution Results, presentation made by Matus Pleva, University of Kosice, Slovakia (TUKE), Progress Report & IO6 Overview and Planning, presentation facilitated by Nayden Chivarov, Institute of Information and Communication Technologies, Bulgaria (IICT-BAS).

The Communication & Dissemination activities within the project were also presented by Ioana Crihană, responsible for Communication & Dissemination on behalf of the National Association of Public Librarians and Libraries in Romania.

TPM3 - The project management meeting ended with a Management Round Table in which the participants discussed the future contribution plans, the steps to follow in the implementation of the planned activities of the project, the expected results and the evaluation of the efforts of monitoring the fulfillment degree of the indicators assumed within the project.
